Description

Students will do research on a specific question and present their findings in the form of a poster and verbal presentation.

Classroom Activities

Ask students to answer the question: What causes school violence?

Students need to answer it by finding three different sources of information on the cause of school violence. Examples are books, magazines, brochures, interview with school principal and so forth. After reading the information, have students summarize the information found in each of the sources, create a poster on the information in an interesting and creative way. Finally, ask student to do a short presentation the information and poster to the class.
